The day dawned cool. A welcome relief from the previous hot day. We departed Perth at 8.08 am with an air of excitement at the prospect of sharing a time of fellowship and prayer with dear friends in the south-west towns of Williams, Narrogin and Popanyinning. Although the day was significantly cool for an average summer day, the bush was nevertheless tinder dry and all too soon with the jarrah forest behind us, undulating fields of cut wheat and canola fields lined with eucalypts and scraggly dried bush lay before us the car headed towards Williams. The team was in good spirits with lots of playful banta ping ponging back and forth between us.

WILLIAMS

Vern Sattler and Kuzie Tuhura were already waiting for us at about 9.55 am as we turned into the grounds of the Anglican parish at Williams. We were heartily greeted and made welcome with coffee and biscuits. Kuzie broke the news to us as gently as he could that he would be leaving Williams at the end of February to take up a position in Bunbury with the Seafarers Mission. This would leave Williams without a minister as no replacement for Kuzie had yet been found.

Vern led a devotional from the Australian Anglican Book of Prayer. We shared a blessed time of worship and sharing the word. There was a tangible and powerful presence of the Holy Spirit as we laid hands upon Vern and then Kuzie and prayed for their needs and ministries in 2017.

A quick photo session followed after prayer for the town and region. With final warm embraces we bid our farewells to these two Godly men who serve so faithfully in Williams and headed out of the church grounds towards our next stop, Narrogin.



By road there is only 30 kilometres between Williams and Narrogin. It read 27 degrees on the vehicle dashboard. The cool of the morning had given way to a pleasant, agreeably warm summers day.

NARROGIN

In no time at all we were driving into Gary Johnson's driveway in anticipation of a feed of his infamous homemade scones. We were not disappointed. As we ate piping hot scones straight from the oven and sipped at our coffees, Gary shared with us the prayer points for Narrogin and the surrounding areas. Although the rumours could not be substantiated, Kadaitcha men (a name for Australian Aboriginal witch doctors) were being brought in from the north-west to lay curses on and around Narrogin. A powerful time of prayer then ensued against the powers of darkness for Narrogin and the region, for souls, salvation, healing and miracles.

There was another photo shoot standing outside Gary's front door before departing from Narrogin for the short 34 km drive to Popanyinning.



POPANYINNING

Sam Maughn was sitting on the seat outside the Popanyinning General Store when we arrived at about 12.40pm. Jenny Maughn greeted us warmly as she ushered us into the kitchen at the back of the store. Around the kitchen table Sam and Jenny lovingly served us homemade sandwiches and fruit cake that we washed down with cold water. Out stomach still full from Gary's scones, none of us could manage too hearty a lunch.

Sam discussed the needs of the district. Due to the Christmas/New Year season church numbers were down but due to pick up again when the school holidays ended and families returned to the town.

On this occasion, Sam's heart was for the state of the world and in particular the evidence from worldly news at how close the world was to fulfilling the end-time prophecy in Daniel 7 of a one world government and one world currency. Sam exhorted us that those in Christ are not to fear and as Sam's heart was heavy he led us in prayer for the world situation. Geoff prayed for the Popanyinning district and prayed a blessing on Sam and Jenny's business, family and home.

For our final photo shoot we sat on the seat outside the store. A man and his granddaughter arrived at this time and recognised Joe O'Donovan as being the Pastor who had performed the funeral service of their loved one. Joe had also baptised the granddaughter in the Pingelly swimming pool many years prior.
